


Missing a single tooth



A single implant will support a single crown and is the ideal solution when compared to conventional alternatives. The treatment is simple and the procedures are very minor when carried out by well trained and experienced surgeons.

It is possible to remove the failed tooth, place the implant and build a tooth directly onto the implant all within a single appointment—instant implants and instant teeth.

Problems

Missing or Failing Tooth

- Due to infection, failed root filling, trauma or root fracture
- Crown keeps falling out or not enough tooth left to attach a new crown
- Tooth failed to develop

Solutions

Implant with single tooth

- Ideal long term solution that looks, feels and functions just like natural teeth
- Option for instant implant and instant tooth
- Protects adjacent teeth and underlying bone helping maintain lip and cheek support
- Very high success rate (over 99%) when compared to alternative treatments

Alternatives

Leave a gap or wear a denture

- Unsightly and embarrassing
- May impair eating and speech
- Bone and gum in the gap will shrink
- The position of adjacent and opposing teeth will distort over time

Bridge from other teeth

- Healthy teeth need to be drilled to attach the bridge, shortening their lifespan making future solutions more complex and costly
- Bone supporting the gum beneath a bridge will shrink due to lack of use leaving a gap
- Extra stress on supporting teeth during chewing
